ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

NORTHERN CALIFORNIA ASSOCIATION FOR INHALATION THERAPY

FIRST: The name of this corporation is NORTHERN CALIFORNIA ASSOCIATION FOR INHALATION THERAPY.

SECOND: The specific and primary purposes for which this corporation is formed:

(a) To encourage and develop on a regional basis educational programs for those persons interested in the field of Inhalation Therapy;

(b) To advance the science, technology, and art of Inhalation Therapy through regional institutes, meetings, lectures, and the preparation and distribution of a newsletter and other materials;

(c) To facilitate cooperation between Inhalation Therapy personnel and the medical profession, hospitals, service companies, industry and other agencies within the region interested in Inhalation Therapy;

(d) The general purposes for which this corporation is formed are solely education, charitable, and eleemosynary purposes under Part One of Division Two of Title One of the Corporations Code, and under Part Three of Division Two of Title Two of the Corporations Code.

(e) This corporation shall have and exercise all rights and powers conferred on corporations under the laws of the State of California, provided, however, that this corporation is not

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empowered to engage in any activity which in itself is not in furtherance of its purposes in the preceding sub-paragraphs of this Article Second.

THIRD: This corporation is organized pursuant to the General Nonprofit Corporation Law of the State of California.

FOURTH: The county in this State where the principal office for the transaction of the business of this corporation is located is Santa Clara County.

FIFTH: The names and addresses of the persons who are to act in in the capacity of directors until the selection of their successors are:

SIXTH: The authorized number and qualifications of members of the corporation, the different classes of membership, if any, the property, voting and other rights and privileges of members, and their liability to dues and assessments and the method of collection thereof, shall be as set forth in the Bylaws.


SEVENTH: This corporation is one which does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof and it is organized solely for nonprofit purposes. Upon the winding up and dissolution of this corporation, after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the corporation, the remaining assets shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation, which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable,


religious and/or scientific purposes and which has established its tax-exempt status under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. If this corporation holds any assets or trust, such assets shall be disposed of in such manner as they may be directed by decree of the superior court of the county in which this corporation's principal office is located, upon petition therefor by the Attorney General or by any person concerned in the liquidation.

EIGHTH: Notwithstanding any statement of purposes or powers set forth in these Articles of Incorporation, this corporation shall not have the power to, and shall not, carry on propaganda or otherwise attempt to assist or aid in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for any public office.

NINTH: The name of the unincorporated association which is being incorporated is NORTHERN CALIFORNIA ASSOCIATION FOR INHALATION THERAPY.
